SEED FUNDING COMPETITION FOR DEVELOPING INNOVATIVE PEDAGOGIC APPROACHES AND TEACHING PRACTICES IN PRME 2021

Closing Date: Thursday 12th August 2021 at 5pm

The United Nations-supported Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME) aims to raise the profile of sustainability in business schools around the world and equip today's business students with the understanding and ability to deliver change tomorrow. In order to achieve this, it is necessary to develop innovative pedagogic approaches and teaching practices. Barriers, however, may exist in terms of lack of funding that prevent individuals or groups putting their ideas into practice. As a result, the UK and Ireland Chapter of PRME is making available three awards up to the value of £1000 to support the development of innovative approaches to pedagogy.

Who can apply?

The competition is open to all faculty in PRME Signatory Schools in the UK and Ireland who are paid-up members of the UK and Ireland Chapter.

How much funding is available and what can it be used for?

Four awards up to the value of £1000 are available. The funding may be used to cover the holding of events, such as workshops and trips, and the development of digital or printed resources.

Successful applicants can draw down funding on a vouched basis between September 2021 and 31st July 2022. Please note, grants cannot be used to purchase equipment, unless this is specialist equipment essential to the project.

How will applications be judged?

Funding will be allocated based on the following criteria:

- Relevance to the objectives of PRME;
- Novel/innovative practice;
- Evidence of need for funding and clear outline of what it will be used for;
- The generation of transferable learning/resources; and
- Collaborative practice.

Applications are particularly welcome in relation to initiatives that are interdisciplinary in nature or addressing topics that are currently underrepresented.

How will outcomes be disseminated?

It is expected that any resources/materials generated from the funding will be available to all PRME UKI members (usually via the website, for example, in a document or webinar) on an open access basis. It is also expected that funding recipients will share the learning from their work through a presentation/workshop at the annual UKI Chapter conference.

What's the time frame?

Closing date for applications is Thursday 12th August 2021 at 5pm, and successful applicants will be notified by 10th September 2021. Funding must drawn down by 31st July 2022.
